### Leiba elected as Chair of the Chamber Executives of Ontario

The recently appointed president and chief executive officer of the Mississauga Board of Trade (MBOT) has been elected as Chair of the Chamber Executives of Ontario (CEO) at the organization's annual general meeting and conference in Burlington.
